~~but~~ The bus took us too far, so we had



CLASSIC PIZZA

- 5 kg Farina Tipo I (mei)
- 2,9 kg H₂O
- 5 g lievito (gdr)
- 140g salt
- 200g ekstra prafu olivenolie

Packageage:

Flour

turn on machine

lievito

water on by one

25l / 25l / 10l.
(leave some left for the salt in the end.)

① around the edges in the mixer

② In the middle

Salt - spread on top of the dough with hands

Water - wait for it to be absorbed and then add more.

Oil - add when the water is absorbed, and the dough is mixed enough to get wetten up.

① around the edges (20 sec)

② In the middle

The more kneaded up it gets in the mixer, the stronger and more compact the dough get.

The dough has to ~~wait~~ Rest for 15-20 minutes.

The break the dough into little balls (200g). And fold the balls even more.



Take the ball and press it flat (1)

then turn around


