



Day 3 - March 19th 2019

- ❖ It was also the 2nd day of school and we played Bingo and I learned a lot of new spanish numbers and sentences.





Day 4 - March 20th 2019

- ❖ After school we visited Girbralfaro, a big castle on the hill in the center of Malaga. It was a beautiful castle and I would probably visit it again.




Day 7 - March 23rd 2019

- ❖ We had a proper guide who told us about the history about Gibraltar and I learned quite a bit from that.




Day 11- March 27th 2019
